High Plains Christian Ministries Foundation Provides Grant

Sharing Hope Ministry is excited to announce that we are expanding our current Bible study curriculum by seven additional studies. This expansion is possible due to funding provided by the High Plains Christian Ministries Foundation. Studies that will soon be available cover issues on depression, suffering, prayer, failure, character, relationships with others, and relationship with God. This is an answer to prayer as we have had several women complete all the studies in our curriculum and show a desire to continue to work through Bible studies to strengthen their faith during their incarceration.

Xcel Community Grant Awarded

A new Bible study on recovery issues is now available to incarcerated women. Funding through Xcel Community Grant allowed Sharing Hope to purchase the first shipment of "Celebrate Recovery Inside". This study is national know and currently being used in many Christ-based Recovery Programs. Women who are incarcerated can use Christian principles as they are working through their recovery of addiction.

Sharing Hope Ministry Has Several Needs:

All six of the women in the Bible study had tears in their eyes as they realized God truly cared about them.
