Patsy Britting Benevolence Fund

Patsy Britting was one of the driving forces behind the Sharing Hope Ministry. Pasty was passionate about witnessing to our area incarcerated women and reflected God's love through her actions. In honor of her work, the Patsy Britting Benevolence Fund has recently been established to provide emergency financial assistance to qualifying local ex-offenders as they work towards a new life with Christ. The goal of this fund is to assist our local

women who endure extenuating circumstances on their way to establishing a new life style, free of the negative influences of previous social structures.

Research on a national level has shown that 48% of released female offenders are re-incarcerated within three years. Recently released women are overwhelmed with the basic; finding adequate housing, a job, regaining custody of their children and accessing required treatment groups. Due to lack of resources, many women feel they have no choice but to return to the same trouble neighborhoods and habits that originally led them to jail. The Patsy Britting Benevolence Fund will provide limited support to women who are actively pursuing a changed lifestyle.


