Sharing Hope volunteers provided over 5,600 hours last year working to assist 14,500 incarcerated women nation wide in their recovery from destructive behavior by sharing God's love and hope through the teaching of His Word.

These volunteers, representing about fifteen different churches, come together to show God's love to the incarcerated women who need Him to make the changes necessary to live a life full of hope. We appreciate not only those workers who come each week but also our donors who keep providing the Bibles and studies that are sent out, and those who keep the ministry lifted up in prayer.



Stepping Stones is the aftercare program designed to provide spiritual encouragement and follow-up support for women who have been incarcerated and are living in Potter or Randall County.

Stepping Stones training will consist of 12 sessions from 6:30 p.m. - 8:30 p.m. on Thursday evenings. Training for new volunteers have been scheduled from June 5th - August 21st.

The women who complete this training will be a key element to the success of the women who will reside at Patsy's Place Transitional Home. As the Stepping Stone Partner, you will assist a woman in making the positive transition to a life free of crime, drugs or other negative influences.
