### It's THE Weekend for Fun!



## EXPANDING OUR BORDERS AGAIN!

In February 2009, the downturn of our nation's economy and the establishment of Patsy's Place Transitional Home led Sharing Hope Ministry to temporarily suspend expansion to new states. Instead, we focused on providing materials to the pre-approved facilities in the states which we had already expanded. Towards the end of 2010, facilities in three additional states were accepted. God is good!... and earlier this year Sharing Hope Ministry made the commitment to once again accept new states as requests were received.

Since that time, Virginia was accepted as the thirty-third state to receive our services. Twelve additional facilities within our currently approved states have been added to the eligible list which now includes 212 correctional and addiction rehabilitation facilities. Sharing Hope Ministry's desire is to never again have to turn down a qualified woman who writes us with her own personal request to know Christ.
