Women from sixteen new facilities have requested and received the Life Recovery Bible this year. There are now over 250 correctional and addiction rehabilitation facilities, in forty-one states, that have been accepted to receive Bibles, Bible studies and prayer each month. Our local incarcerated and recovering women can also benefit from jail visitation, mentoring and aftercare.

Since 2006, when Sharing Hope Ministry expanded our vision to provide our services outside of Texas, over 61,820 Life Recovery Bibles have been provided to women who have asked for help. It is our community in Christ that has allowed so many Bibles to be placed in the hands of these searching women. You are invited to join this community through investing your resources.

By Volunteering...an hour each week to provide Christ-centered services to the increasing amount of women reaching out for help.

Over the last 3 years, Patsy's Place Transitional Home has served the needs of over 25 women who have benefited from being a part of this Christ-centered re-entry program for previously incarcerated women. Patsy's Place allows Christ's transforming grace and truth to work through educational classes, mentorship, case management, counseling and recovery programs to restore women to be contributing members in the community, bearing witness that no life is beyond the reach of the restorative power of Jesus Christ. The women are empowered and equipped to not only discover, but walk, in the abundant life God has given them through Jesus, and guess what? I personally have been so blessed to part of this process!

Patsy's Place provides for the basic needs of these women, along with special needs (e.g. prescription medication, dental work, eye glasses, birth certificates, driver's licenses/identification card). All of this, combined with program needs can become a demanding financial burden, but I believe the outcome far outweighs the needs. Did you know that women who participate in a faith-based aftercare program are less likely to reoffend?

Knowing that I have a hand in allowing a woman to fully embrace her God-intended purpose for her life is why I give.

Starting in August, our volunteers and supporters will be working together with a goal to raise \$30,000 for Patsy's Place. But more than that, we want our community to have a better understanding of our mission and vision for these women.
