2013 was a blessed year, full of surprises. Hope Fest was wildly successful, thanks to the wonderful opportunity that Hillside Christian Church offered in matching \$20,000 of funds raised, which was successfully met! In May, the 100,000th Bible was mailed to a woman in Arizona which was an exciting and momentous occasion. Christmas in October was one of the best years yet, grossing the highest amount ever in overall funds, notably in the Bake Sale area (pumpkin bread, anyone?). Even more, many of our regular vendors and attendees of Christmas in October expressed their support and encouragement of the ministry, which was a change from past years. If you attended the craft show, you may have noticed signs informing customers that \$15.00 spent at the Bake Sale or Admissions would buy a Bible for a woman in need. Just \$15.00 makes a difference. Thank you for making 2013 a year full of "bests" and we hope to continue that trend starting with this year's Hope Fest on March 27th!

What's Next? What lies ahead for 2014, you ask? Well, let us share with you...

Goal #1: Start renovation on the Sharing Hope Ministry offices located in the building that houses Patsy's Place Transitional Home. The renovation will cover the ground floor of the existing building. The expansion will provide offices for the Sharing Hope Ministry staff, improved and expanded workspace for our volunteers and warehouse capability for thousands of Bibles and studies that arrive and are mailed from the office. The supplies that we will now be able to store will be used to aid our local women in an amazing way. Likewise, the new and improved workspace will help us to better serve women all over our country.

Goal #2: It is our goal every year to reach more women. The Lord has opened many doors for women to come to know Him and we are blessed to see His glory spread! This year, we want to reach more souls in new facilities so that more woman may change their lives through Him.

Goal #3: Start an annual fundraiser specifically for Patsy's Place. This fun'raiser will be designed to help Patsy's Place become more financially independent, while providing a fun event that the whole family will want to attend each and every year!


Star Parker
